Guidance on Amendments and Revisions to the Aerodrome Manual

An "amendment" to the Aerodrome Manual is a significant change in the method of compliance to Government Decree "Landsbesluit Toezicht Luchtvaart" Official Gazette P.B. 2003 No 56, the CCAR part 14 – 14.2.16, by an aerodrome operator. Amendments must be submitted to the CCAA at least 45 days before the proposed effective date, in order to enable the CCAA to review and approve the amendment. A shorter time period may be allowed under circumstances beyond the control of the aerodrome operator after consultation with the Aerodrome Inspector. Examples of what constitutes an amendment:

- Wildlife Hazard Management Plan developed;
- Change in ARFF Category;
- Change in frequency/responsibility of safety inspections;
- Change in responsibility of basic emergency medical care;
- Significant change in physical facilities, such as a new runway or runway extension.
- · Changes resulting from an annual Emergency Plan review.

A "**revision**" to the Aerodrome Manual is an updating of information to maintain currency, which is not a change in method of compliance and does not require CCAA approval. Revisions are submitted as needed to maintain currency of the Aerodrome Manual and should have a date of issue. Examples of what constitutes a revision:

- · Updating names of key personnel;
- · New replacement ARFF vehicle;
- Minor change in physical facilities, such as new apron or taxiway extension.

Guidance on Amendment to the Aerodrome Certificate

CCAA Form "Application for an Aerodrome Certificate" (Appendix 1 of the Aerodrome Inspector Guidance Handbook, document CCAA.AGA.001) may be used in applying for amendments to the Aerodrome Certificate, as dictated by Government Decree "Landsbesluit Toezicht Luchtvaart" (Official Gazette P.B. 2003 No 56), article 175, paragraph 3:

- "3. Het certificaat luchtvaartterrein kan door de Minister worden gewijzigd:
 - a. op verzoek van de exploitant van het luchtvaartterrein;
 - b. bij wijziging van de eigendom van het luchtvaartterrein of in het bestuur van de exploitant van het luchtvaartterrein:
 - c. bij wijziging in het gebruik of van de operatie van het luchtvaartterrein
 - d. bij wijziging van de grenzen van het luchtvaartterrein."

Guidance to an Aerodrome Authorizations and limitations

An "amendment" to an Aerodrome Authorization and limitation is a significant change in the method of compliance to Government Decree "Landsbesluit Toezicht Luchtvaart" Official Gazette P.B. 2003 No 56 and CCAR part 14 by an aerodrome operator.

Aerodrome amendments must be submitted to the CCAA at least 45 days before the proposed effective date, in order to enable the CCAA to review and approve the amendment. A shorter time period may be allowed under circumstances beyond the control of the aerodrome operator after consultation with the Aerodrome Inspector.
